3. At what point would you suggest the 12 stepper receive medical help for acute withdrawal?

4. Should you ever give a drunk a drink on a 12 step call?

5. What do you do with a wet drunk that shows up at an AA meeting?

Open discussion followed. I think we all came up with different answers to the same question. As a group I think we learned that common sense and prudence for everyone's safety should prevail. The roll playing got a lot of laughs.

We all had a good time, while at the same time learning how to carry the message to the wet drunk.
