All volunteers attended, including those who were not yet approved. The detention center OK'd any volunteer waiting for approval to participate so long as their application was on file.

Inmates were informed the literature was free.

Though I was not able to personally attend the Area Assembly on Jan. 14<sup>th</sup>, other team members did and said the correctional workshop was informative and productive and they are looking forward to the next workshop in March. Everyone is very enthusiastic & upbeat, and we are looking forward to a good year.
