

DISTRICT 28 MEETING MINUTES
OCTOBER 2021

OPEN :- DCM Bob M. opened the meeting with a moment of silence followed by the Serenity Prayer and read the Declaration Of Unity and the Responsibility Statement.

NEW GSR :- Patty M. was welcomed as the new GSR from the Women to Women Group.

Roll Call :- Nine GSR's were present for voting.

SECRETARY :- The minutes of the previous meeting were accepted.

TREASURER :- Bob M. presented a report showing an operating deficit of \$193.50 for the month and a closing balance of \$7229.01. Bob's report was accepted and will be submitted for audit at the end of the year. Bob also presented a proposed budget for 2022 and it will be voted on at the next meeting.

ARCHIVES:- Denis S. said he was looking forward to presenting the Archives at the upcoming Gratitude Dinner and also said that he might resume the business of recording longtimers and asking webmaster Steve to post to the website where there are already many such personal stories.

CORRECTIONS:- Bob M. said it was regrettable that we are presently unable to do any service work in this area as the jail is still operating under Covid 19 protocols.

INTERGROUP LIASON:- Brian M. gave a summary of the Intergroup Business Meeting which was held immediately prior to the District 28 meeting.

CPC:- Janet B. said she had been particularly busy the past month and she listed the following places she had visited. Central Motel, Sheriff's Station, Chamber of Commerce, Holiday Inn, Inverness Welcome Center, the Library, State Probation, Langley House and Access Health. She said she had left Where and Whens at all those locations and that they were very well received.

WEBSITE:- Bob M. reported that Steve N. was keeping everything up to date and that he hoped to be back with us soon.

DCM:- Bob M. thanked everyone who had persisted through Covid and regretted that it is still not possible to get into Treatment Centers or Detention Centers. Bob also distributed a flyer about an Area 14 Workshop which will be held on Zoom. He also asked that unsold tickets for the Gratitude Dinner be returned at the next meeting so that they can be redistributed.

OLD BUSINESS:- A motion was passed to untable a previous discussion concerning the inclusion of Detox phone numbers on the Where and Whens. A new motion was made to remove both the numbers and the disclaimer. That motion was defeated and the Where and Whens will carry the phone numbers with the disclaimer.
