

DISTRICT 28 MEETING MINUTES

FEBRUARY 2022

OPEN:- DCM Bob M. opened the meeting with a moment of silence followed by the Serenity Prayer, the Declaration of Unity and the Responsibility Statement.

ROLL:- There were seven GSRs eligible to vote.

SECRETARY:- The minutes of the previous meeting were accepted.

TREASURER:- Dave D. gave a report and a copy is attached. Dave's report was accepted and will be submitted for audit at year's end. The closing balance was \$10,259.65.

ARCHIVES:- Denis S. said he would continue with efforts to acquire more audio, visual and digital items for the Archives. He encouraged taking the Journal for distribution. Dean H. said he would be attending the Archives Roundtable at the weekend.

MEN'S CORRECTIONS:- Bob M. reported that 7 people are ready and eager to resume visits to the jail when Covid Restrictions are removed.

WOMEN'S CORRECTIONS:- April M. said that Covid Restrictions had prevented visits to jail. She indicated that she was looking for someone to take the position.

GRAPEVINE:- Don H. made a Grapevine Presentation on behalf of District 28 to the Area Assembly.

INTERGROUP:- Brian M. said that he had attended the Intergroup Meeting prior to the District Meeting and gave a summary of the discussions that took place.

PUBLIC INFORMATION and CPC:- Janet B. forwarded a list of locations where information had been distributed. Included were the following: Salvation Army, Driver Improvement, Sheriff's Main Station- Inverness, Sheriff's Sub Station- Crystal River, Chamber of Commerce, Inverness City Hall, Pregnancy & Life Center, Access Health, Lakes Regional Library, Central Motel, and Holiday Inn Express.

WEBMASTER:- Steve N. reported that he and Brian C. have been diligently working on improvements to the website. There is an opportunity to use a new posting site that will increase the amount of storage from 30 GB to 50 GB. The cost of the current one is \$125 per year. The new one is offered at \$25 for the first year and \$99 per year thereafter. Further consideration will be given and November is the time when a change could be made.

DCM:- Bob M. said that he had been offered the Men's Corrections Chair at the Area level but had to turn it down because of being so busy with District 28 and Nature Coast Intergroup.

NEW BUSINESS:- A motion to nominate Jeanna H. for the position of Secretary was made and passed. She looks forward to serving in this new position.

A motion was made to raise the budget for storage by \$30 per month due to cost increase. The motion was passed.

Another motion was made to increase the budget for P.O. Box 950 by \$38 per year to cover costs. The motion was passed.

A motion was made for a one time increase of \$29 to the budget for Archives to reimburse Quentin for expenditures associated with the television purchase. The motion was passed.

A reminder was made about the Intergroup Chili Cook Off to be held on Saturday, February 12 from 2-5 at Calvary Chapel in Inverness.

Dean H. expressed the need for a rolling trolley cart that would allow Archives bins and displays to be more easily transported to events. He agreed to shop and report back.
