

## DISTRICT 28 MEETING MINUTES

October 2022

OPEN:- DCM Bob M. opened the meeting with a moment of silence followed by the Serenity Prayer, the Declaration of Unity and the Responsibility Statement.

ROLL:- There were 8 GSRs eligible to vote.

SECRETARY:- Jeanna H. read the minutes of the previous meeting. They were accepted.

TREASURER:- Dave D. gave a report and a copy is attached. Dave's report will be submitted for audit at year's end. The closing balance was \$8,871.75.

ARCHIVES:- Dean B. gave an update on the ongoing plea for Oldtimers' Histories. Many of us have sponsors and friends who have 20+ years of sobriety in Citrus County. We don't want to lose our local history by missing out on these important conversations before our Oldtimers pass. A suggestion was made that a copy of questions to guide our 'Coffee Cup Conversations' be available for print on both the NCI and District websites.

Dean also reminded us that individual Groups can plan an "Archives Meeting" where we can experience some AA history in video format. What an awesome opportunity to see history come to life and share personal insights with our fellows! Dean has graciously offered to coordinate these meetings.

MEN'S CORRECTIONS:- Bob M. reports that the meetings are going well. The team is seeing around 150 inmates per month. There are some changes coming soon. The current chaplain is moving from Citrus and it is uncertain when a new chaplain will be in place. Since different chaplains have different methods of service, orientation for new volunteers to the jail will be on hold for now. Bob does report that he has been building a good relationship with the new warden and appreciates the opportunity to serve.

PUBLIC INFORMATION and CPC:- Janet B. reports that there has been a good response to A.A. literature at many of the locations. Mike G. agreed to assist Janet in getting the literature to all parts of the county. New "Where and Whens" were distributed.

WEBMASTER:- Steve N. reports that the migration from Go Daddy to ICESoft is now complete. There is a common interface across both platforms and there is room for more data. Each officer has been given their own email account.

DCM:- Bob M. expressed his appreciation for those who have worked in service.

NEW BUSINESS:- District Elections were held for DCM, Alt DCM, Secretary and Treasurer. Nominees for positions were made and votes were taken. For our next panel, those serving will be: Bob M. as DCM, Dave D. as Treasurer, and Jeanna H. as Secretary. The Alternate DCM position is currently open.
